ASSISTED LIVING COMMUNITIES continue to be one of the most cost-effective options for long-term care, according to a new study of nearly 15,000 long-term care providers nationwide. The median annual rate for a private room in an assisted living community is \$42,000. The median annual rate in a nursing home is \$77,380 for a semi-private room and \$87,600 for a private room, the study found. In addition to longterm care facilities, the report found that the median annual rate is \$45,188 for home health aides and \$16,900 for adult day health care.
