BLAST-INDUCED TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY

(TBI) has become an important issue in combat casualty care. In many cases of mild TBI, MRI scans and other conventional imaging technology do not show overt damage to the brain. "Our research reveals...there is a lot of molecular madness going on in the brain after a blast exposure," "Even subtle injuries resulted in significant alterations of brain chemistry." Gene activity patterns, which shifted over time, resembled patterns seen in neurodegenerative diseases, particularly Alzheimer's.

GENETICS & LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE

A recent study entitled, "Genetic Testing for Alzheimer's and Long-Term Care Insurance," found that individuals who take a genetic test to find out if they have traits that lead to Alzheimer's are five times more likely to purchase long-term care insurance (LTCI). This is causing LTCI providers to change underwriting standards that may impact individuals with Huntington's Disease (HD). The leading LTCI insurer, Genworth Financial (GF), has announced changes to their underwriting plan design, including higher rates and stricter underwriting standards before insuring risk. GF announced that it may in some cases require genetic testing of LTCI applicants with a family history of genetic disorders, like Huntington's disease. A session at a recent conference was entitled "Genetic Testing: Underwriting Risk or Fear", HD was used in a case example.
