#### AMYOTROPHIC LATERAL SCLEROSIS (ALS) is a

motor neuron disease, first described in 1869 by French neurologist Jean-Martin Charcot. Most commonly, the disease strikes people between the ages of 40 and 70. It's a neurodegenerative disease that usually attacks both upper and lower motor neurons and causes degeneration throughout the brain and spinal cord. A common first symptom is a painless weakness in a hand, foot, arm or leg, which occurs in more than half of all cases. As the disease progresses, it robs patients of the use of their hands, arms and legs, as well as their ability to speak, swallow and, ultimately, breathe on their own. Familial ALS (genetically handed down between generations) represents between 5-10% of all cases. The rest happen spontaneously and mysteriously, making seemingly random attacks on previously healthy adults. ALS can strike anyone, anytime. Lou Gehrig brought worldwide attention to the disease in 1939, when he abruptly retired from baseball after his ALS diagnosis.

#### **DEPRESSION and DEMENTIA**

The relationship between dementia and depression is another two-way street. While depression may be caused by memory loss, on its own it raises the risk of Alzheimer's and other dementias. Inflammation of the brain tissue that occurs when a person is depressed might impact the risk of dementia, according to recent research. Certain proteins found in the brain that increase with depression may also increase the risk. Several lifestyle factors related to long-term depression, such as diet and the amount of exercise and social time a person engages in, could also affect whether they develop dementia. Depression also raises the risk of diabetes, stroke, hypertension, sleep disorders and infection — and, in turn, this makes it harder to manage those conditions. Depression also is linked with substance abuse and suicide risk. www.mayoclinic.org

important in identifying the owners in case of an accident, loss of memory, states of unconsciousness, being inadvertently misplaced in a napkin at a dining table, on admission to a hospital, and other possible issues. Please make sure your Loved One has his or her own teeth with identification on them, especially when they are living in a memory care unit. Personal items can make their way to other resident's rooms and cause a lot of anguish, costs and grief for the family and the resident. As part of the obligation of the profession, a dental practitioner needs to maintain meticulous dental records of his patients. This would include documenting the identity of dentures.
