## Florida Approves First-in-the-Nation Blood Clot Tracking System

Florida's new law, the Emily Adkins Family Protection Act, aims to improve blood clot prevention, screening, and care by creating a statewide Venous Thromboembolism (VTE) registry, requiring hospitals and ambulatory surgical centers to implement VTE risk assessment protocols and train staff, and is mandating informational pamphlets for residents in nursing homes and assisted living facilities. This law also requires hospitals to report VTE data to the new registry. The legislation, is named for a Florida woman who died of a pulmonary embolism in 2022 at age 23 following an ankle fracture. Many clots can be preventable with early detection and intervention.



Myth: Medicaid only covers nursing home care.

Fact: Medicaid covers various long-term care services, including nursing home care, assisted living, and home and community-based services. Eligibility for these services may vary by state and individual needs, and some programs, like home and community-based services, aim to keep individuals in their homes rather than in institutions. Qualifying for home and assisted living Medicaid care in Florida requires the individual to first get on a priority wait list. For more information, attend a seminar or schedule a free consult.

#### **Veterans Services PINELLAS**

Dementia can be service-connected for a veteran. You must also provide evidence that shows a connection between your service and the dementia diagnosis. This could involve:

- 1. A history of Traumatic Brain Injury during service.
- 2. A condition known to be associated with dementia (e.g., Parkinson's disease, Lewy body dementia).
- 3. Establish a link to other service-related events, diagnosis', or exposures that may have caused or increased the risk of developing a dementia (e.g., type 2 diabetes, Agent Orange, PTSD, etc.). Call: (727)464-8460 https://pinellas.gov/department/veterans-services/
